Program Overview

This NSF program aims to cultivate a skilled workforce by preparing highly qualified cybersecurity professionals.

The SFS scholarship is a prestigious award that offers generous stipend, allowance, and full tuition for two years to eligible US citizens and US permanent residents.

Following graduation, scholarship recipients are required to work in cybersecurity for a federal, state, local, or tribal Government organization for at least 2 years.
